What are Talu FireBriqs ?

Made from recycled clean wood waste, Talu FireBriqs are an environmentally friendly alternative wood fuel for burning in Wood burning stoves, open fires, Chimenas, BBQ's, Firepits and Biomass Boilers.

FireBriqs

- Burn hotter for longer compared to 'seasoned' logs
- Only 8% moisture content
- Are cleaner to handle
- Produce Less Spitting/Less Ash
- Produce Lower Tar deposits in your chimney/flue
- Utilises a waste product which would have gone to landfill
- Contain no binding ingredients, additives or chipboard
- Can be lit and used the same way as coal and logs

How does the TALU FireBriq work?

We recommend lighting a Firebriq fire in the following way as this does not require the use of any kindling or paper to get the fire started:

- Place two Firebriqs on their sides about 1" apart with a third block over the top forming a bridge.*
- Place a couple of firelighters in the gap, and light.
- If you are using a wood burning stove, open up the draw and baffle to get the fire burning initially. When the appliance reaches a suitable temperature, damp down to leave your preferred flame pattern.
- Resist the temptation to poke a Firebriq fire as this will break up the blocks and increase air flow into the centre of the fire, this will substantially reduce the burn time.
- When required place another one or two Firebriqs onto the fire.

***A note of caution.** Take care not to overload the fire with Firebriqs as they burn very hot. Care should also be taken for some hours after the fire has died down as the ash may remain hot for up to 12 hours. It is usually possible to re-ignite the fire by placing 2 new Firebriqs into the hot ash and opening the draw until the fire is actively burning once again.
